Tips for Billy Footwear shoes: follow this process when you put the shoes on for the first time with your brace.

- 1. Put on your AFO
- 2. Unzip the shoe all the way, loosen up the laces a lot, and remove the insert
- 3. Put the foot with the AFO in the shoe
- 4. Zip up the shoe
- 5. Lace up the shoe

From now on you should not have to untie and tie the shoes again. If the shoe seems too big, add the insert again.

Socks:

A quick online search will bring up some good options, but Woodle Co socks are generally great for kids, while SmartKnit socks work especially well for adults.
